

Amryt Pharmaceuticals 2022 Methodological Note – UK Members of the Public Reporting

Reporting:	<p>This report includes all fees for contracted services made to Members of the Public as defined by ABPI’s requirements for Transparency.</p> <p>When remuneration and/or travel is provided in association with speaking services, assistance with training, writing articles and/or publications, participating in advisory boards, advising on the design or other aspects of clinical trials, and/or participating in market research such payments will be disclosed.</p>
Tax/VAT considerations:	Yearly amounts for each Member of the Public are disclosed without VAT
Currency (including conversion rates):	All reported amounts are in British pounds. If the payment is made in another currency, the amount is converted to British Pounds with the rate on the date of the payment.
Transfer of Value Date:	<p>For payments related to contracts and services reimbursed or paid directly to the Member of the Public (check or cash equivalent), the payment date is utilized for reporting.</p> <p>For in-direct expenses provided in-kind to a Member of the Public (such as travel and lodging) provided on behalf of Amryt, the date that the Member of the Public received the expense is the date utilized for reporting.</p>
Multi-year contracts:	The Company reports all payments made to the reported Member of the Public during the submission year. If a contract contemplated payments to be made in subsequent calendar years, those payments will be reflected in those subsequent calendar years’ filings.
Consent:	Consent from the Member(s) of the Public was not gained as the report does not disclose the identity of such individuals.
Cross Border Payments:	The Company will disclose based on the principal address of the Member of the Public regardless of the location where the payment was made.
Aggregate vs Individual Disclosure	<p>Payments made to to Members of the Public will be disclosed in an aggregate total.</p> <p>Recipients of payments will be split into one of three groups: patients, journalists or the public. The total amount spent and the total number of recipients for each category will be detailed in the report.</p>
Payment Details:	Payments will be placed into one of two categories for each recipient group: fees or expenses. A description of the types of services that are provided that sufficiently enables the reader to understand the nature of services provided without disclosing confidential information will be included.
